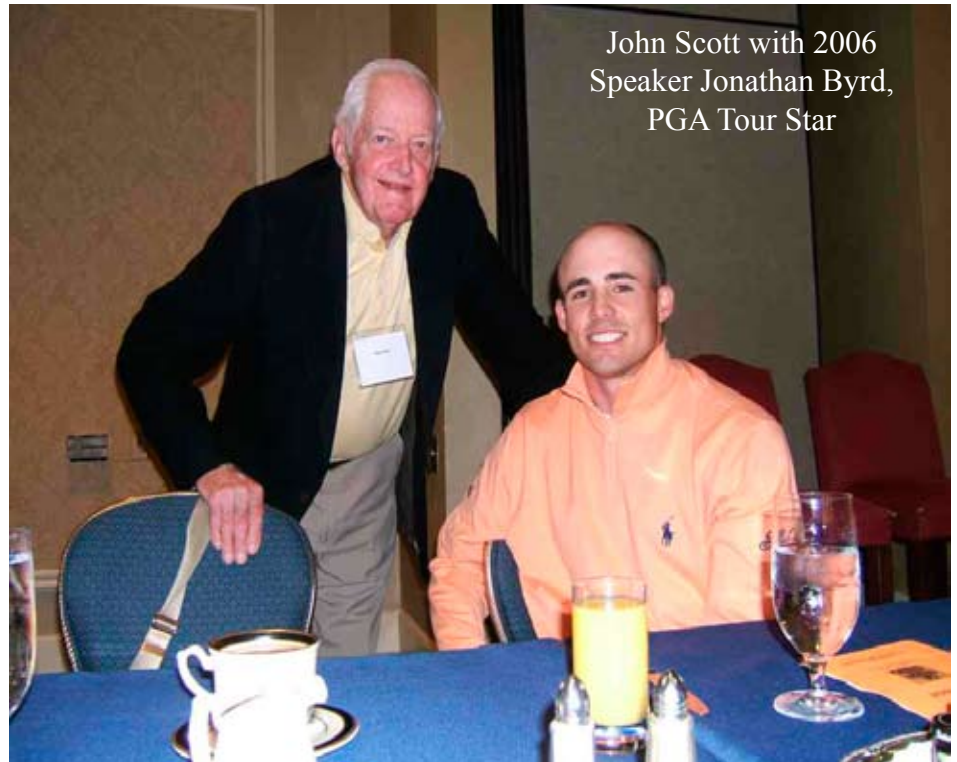

This successful program sparked the idea of getting an outstanding golfer on the PGA Tour who was an active member of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. John thought there might be a special program for the week of The Heritage and the MOC breakfast. In April, 1997, John got Tom Lehman, rented the Crowne Plaza Ballroom, filled it with nearly 700 people for a 7:00AM breakfast and, as they say, "the rest is history".

Over the past 10 years, along with Tom Lehman, the MOC has secured such speakers as Steve Jones, Loren Roberts, Doug Barron, Stewart

Cink, Larry Mize, Bernard Langer, David Gossett and Jonathan Byrd. These have all been outstanding events due largely to the efforts of retiring Christian Heritage Breakfast Chairman John Scott and his work with the FCA Golf Ministry.

This year, John will be turning the microphone over to his good friend and fellow Men of the Church Council member, Mike Brock. Our speaker will be none other than last year's Verizon Heritage champion and very active member of FCA, Aaron Baddeley. We want to thank John for his years of hard work and dedication to this world-class event.
