Following the theme of our MOC Ethics Symposium last month, our December breakfast speaker is Lee Ozley, an ethics consultant. Lee has spent 35+ years as a coach, advisor, and consultant to more than 100 public and private sector organizations in North America and Europe.

Born and raised in Alabama, Lee received a BS degree in economics and a BA degree in industrial psychology from Auburn University. Following military service, he completed graduate work at the University of Wisconsin. He has spent time in both union and management leadership positions.

Lee and Rich Teerlink, retired CEO of Harley-Davidson, co-authored *More than a Motorcycle: The leadership Journey at Harley-Davidson* published by Harvard Business School Press in 2000. Lee also completed another book, *Experience Lessons: Leading Organizations in the Warp-Speed Changing Global Marketplace*, published by Cameo Publications, in February 2005.

Now Lee is semi-retired here on Hilton Head, working with a small number of select clients while writing, teaching, helping build homes with Habitat for Humanity, and improving his golf game. He is serving as a coach and advisor to the Board of Directors of the Regional Red Cross Chapter. He is also a frequent guest lecturer at conferences and universities.
