You'll want to be at Breakfast on Thursday, November 8th, to hear Rev. Ward Scovel, PhD, Chaplain of Hospice Care of the Lowcountry, and his presentation "Care and the Caregiver." Ward has served in this capacity since 2006. A retired Methodist minister, he provides non-denominational spiritual guidance for Hospice patients and their families. He also offers spiritual support for Hospice staff members. At Hospice Care of the Lowcountry, the philosophy of care is more about living than about dying. Their mission is to help their patients and their families find the fullness and joy they deserve as life travelers, even as they near the anxieties of the end of the journey. Spiritual care is part of the general care plan for all Hospice Care patients, but does not replace an individual's personal faith leader. Rather, Ward offers care in tandem with a person's spiritual guide. For more than 50 years, he has served in some form of ministry in several states. With his wife, Mary, music therapist for Hospice Care of the Lowcountry, he moved to Hilton Head Island in 2001.

Jenny Brasington, Hospice's Director of Patient Services, will accompany Ward Scovel to our breakfast meeting. Both will be available after Ward's talk to answer your questions.
